

Purpose/Objective of Event: To commemorate and reenact the 245th Anniversary of the Battle of Brandywine, the largest single day engagement of the American Revolution. In coordination with local municipalities activities to commemorate and historical education of the sacrifices of the participants on both sides of the conflict.

Venue and Access

Sandy Hollow Heritage Park is a local municipal Park controlled by Birmingham Township, Pennsylvania

It consists of 42 acres of preserved open space, much as it was in 1777, allows public access for passive recreation and historical education.

It is part of the Brandywine Battlefield National Historic Landmark

The park will be used exclusively for commemorative activities being held by the Townships

Located right off US Route 202, easily reached from either 195, 1276, or US Route 1

Approximately 35 miles west of Philadelphia

Infrastructure

Birmingham Township will tentatively provide
